Type of wine	Red Wine
Grape varieties	60 % Merlot, 40 % Cabernet Sauvignon
Soil	Gravelly hill on the commune of Budos
Age of the vines	35
Yearly prod.	
Harvest	Manual and selective sorting
Vinification	Staking of 85% of the grapes, fermentation in vats for 21 to days depending on the year; then, malolactic fermentation. The special production on 2 hectares of old vineyard hand-picked is raised for twelve months in new barrels and gives our special « Cuvée vieillie en Fût de chêne ». Ageing in oak barrels
Drink tips	Meat, aperitif, cheese...
Tasting	The result is a wine with a fragrance both strong and complex; it develops an elegant structure with a slight touch of wood without overcoming a supple and delicate taste of its own
